The Philippines has one of the biggest numbers of overseas workers in the world, deploying more than 2 million in 2019. There is a Filipino worker in almost every country in the world except for North Korea. Healthcare, construction, travel and tourism, production and services are sectors in which overseas Filipino workers (OFW) have excelled.

Close to 50 percent of Filipinos deployed abroad are employed in the service sector, particularly travel and tourism. In Italy, where Filipinos are one of the biggest ethnic groups, the Philippines deploys domestic workers and restaurant staff equally.

**Excellent English communication skills.** The Philippines is one of the largest English-speaking countries in the world, with more than 70 percent of the population fluent in the language. English is the medium of instruction in schools, and the language of commerce and law. Filipinos' neutral accent in English is comprehensible, and makes them easy to train for work in call centers.



**High literacy rate.** The Philippines has the highest literacy rate in Southeast Asia, at more than 97 percent, according to a report by the United Nations. Filipinos above 15 years old, whether employed or unemployed, had almost the same literacy rate, at 96.1 percent. A huge percentage of overseas Filipino workers are degree holders, driven abroad because of the lack of employment opportunities in the Philippines.



**Certified and trained to world-class standards.** The Philippines has a strong local tourism industry, with more than 4 million employed in this sector, consisting of international chains of four- to five-star hotels and resorts. Prior to working in travel and tourism industry, candidates undergo rigid training and secure certification from the government's Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) that they are skilled in hotel housekeeping, valet servicing, bartending, cookery, food and beverage, and front office services.
